Giving





Giving ourselves

First of all we recognise that Christian giving starts with us responding to God by giving ourselves. *"Therefore I urge you, in view of God's mercy, to offer yourselves as living sacrifices."* (Romans 12:1). Christian giving isn't primarily about money, there's an attitude of giving everything we are and have to God. That includes our time and our abilities.

Giving Financially

In the Bible the people of God acknowledged that everything they had came from God and gave generously. *"Everything comes from you and we have given you only what comes from your hand."* (1 Chronicles 29:14).

In order to support various Christian works outside our church, there are from time to time special collections or fundraising activities. With these we usually try to promote awareness of the wider work of God and prayer alongside giving.

With a full compliment of staff in our Ministry Team and the importance of continuing to financially support ministries both within the Church and through other organisations, the Church members approved a budget for 2017-18 that requires a 5% increase in giving.

Other Giving

Each week there is a collection of non-perishable food items. These are collected by the Engage Group, part of Churches Together in Hucknall, Linby and Papplewick, and distributed to local families in need.

Some important information about Gift Aid to the church:

To enable the church to claim additional income from HMRC, all that is needed is for all who pay income tax at present to indicate this fact and simply state that they wish for the church to accept their offering as Gift Aid.

It is necessary to have envelopes or standing order so that the treasurers can add up the entire Gift Aided amounts and keep records and claim about 24 pence in every pound given to the Church in this way.

You see how easy it is and what a real bonus it can be for the church. If you pay income tax, whether earning or receiving a pension please seriously consider this and tick the appropriate box on the response form.
